Training:

We will give volunteers a copy of this policy and any health & safety induction or briefing for any event hosted by Y:AMHS.

Consultation:

We will consult with the board and volunteers routinely on health & safety matters as they arise, and at least on review of the health & safety policy.

Evacuation:

We will identify and comply with any escape routes in any premises or venue at which Y:AMHS operates.
